A Girlfriend's Guide to Survival

We live in a crazy world and one of the keys to a woman's survival is God's gift of friendship. Having friends to do life together can be fun and fulfilling. When life gets tough and trials get in our way, friends are essential. If we're not careful though, we can find ourselves falling into the trap of comparison and competition. We might even begin to take our friendships for granted. In this session, Leah will teach the keys to healthy friendships found in 2 Corinthians 13:11 (NLT), "Be joyful. Grow to maturity. Encourage each other. Live in harmony and peace. Then, the God of love and peace will be with you."

Being a Fashionista

Imagine what it would be like to wear expensive runway designer clothes and be known as a real Fashionista! Well, the truth is, as women we are individually and uniquely fashioned by the Master Designer. With love and tender care God has delicately woven you into a one-of-a-kind masterpiece. He has draped you with unique gifts, and abilities while shaping you with real life experiences. In this session, Leah will teach you how to recognize and embrace your own talents, abilities, and spiritual gifts instead of longing for someone else's. This message is based on Genesis 2, where we will uncover details about the very first woman God fashioned on earth, and what we can learn from her.

Becoming a Woman of Audacious Faith

The Bible tells us that without faith it is impossible to please God. As women, we want to have unshakable faith but oftentimes our own fears, doubts, and insecurities can keep us from experiencing the adventurous life we long for. Meet a woman tucked deep in the pages of Scripture who risked everything, while taking a leap of audacious faith, to experience a miracle from Jesus. Her story will inspire you and reveal the steps you'll need to embrace, so that you can start living a life of audacious faith too!

It's Only a Masquerade

In this session, Leah shares her personal testimony of years spent hiding behind a mask of perfectionism, people-pleasing, and performance-based living. When her mask fell and shattered into a million pieces, Leah was left holding a medical diagnosis of Generalized Anxiety Disorder and Chronic Depression. The masquerade was over and her life could have ended there, but through God's grace and mighty hand, Leah was pulled from the pit and journeyed the uphill road to recovery. In this session, Leah shares the life changing lessons she learned along the way to recovery and uncovers the secrets that keep her from falling back into the pit.



Living Out Your Legacy

What kind of legacy do you want to leave for those you love? How do you want to be remembered by your spouse, children, and grandchildren? Are you living a life that reflects the inheritance you hope to pass along to others? In this session, Leah shares her experience of losing both parents within a very short period of time and how it dramatically changed her perspective on what a true legacy really means. Leah will reveal the keys to living out your legacy one day at a time and how you can give a priceless inheritance to those you love. How you live your life matters to those who will follow behind you.

Secret Confessions of a M.O.P.S. Survivor

Do you ever find yourself saying things like *Parenting is so hard! No one ever told me kids would be so high maintenance. I'm not very good at being a mom. Am I messing up my kids by giving into them all the time?* In this session, Leah shares funny confessions of her own mishaps and mommy blunders while exposing secrets to successful parenting from a biblical perspective. Discover the tools needed that will build confidence in your parenting style while improving the child-parent relationship and drawing your children to the heart of God. Key Verse: Children are a gift from the LORD. They are a reward from Him. Psalm 127:3 *This session is designed for MOPS groups. It can also be tailored for parents with youth, tweens, or teens.

My Body, His Temple

As women, we can fall into the trap of neglecting ourselves because we're too busy taking care of everyone else's needs. It may seem like the right thing to do but is it really biblical? Did you know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit? Are you maintaining a space where He will feel welcomed and comfortable? How well are you taking care of yourself? In this session, Leah uncovers truths about the real you. As Christians, we are made up of three parts: body-soul-spirit. Discover the importance of each part and be equipped to maintain a healthy lifestyle that will keep you vitalized while glorifying God. Key Verse: Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body. 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 *This topic is great for a one day conference or 2-day retreat package (3 sessions)
